

Year to Date Performance Summary

Between January and June 2011 there were 453 casualties recorded - an increase of three casualties when compared with 2010. Casualties killed or seriously injured have increased by 14 casualties (63.6%), whilst those slightly injured have reduced by 11 casualties (-2.6%). This has resulted in the severity ratio worsening by 3.0 percentage points.

Child KSI's have also increased from two during 2010, to seven during 2011. Total child casualties have increased by 14.3% (from 49 to 56 casualties). Pedal Cycle casualties have increased by 18, or 85.7%. Motorcycle casualties have also increased.
