Stoke City Performance Summary

During 2010 there were 948 casualties recorded - a decrease of 94 casualties (9%) when compared with the previous year. The number of casualties killed or seriously injured has also reduced by 8 casualties, or 15% whilst slight casualties have also reduced by 86 casualties, or 9%. The severity ratio has reduced by 0.3 percentage points between the two years, with 4.7% of all casualties being killed or seriously injured during 2010.

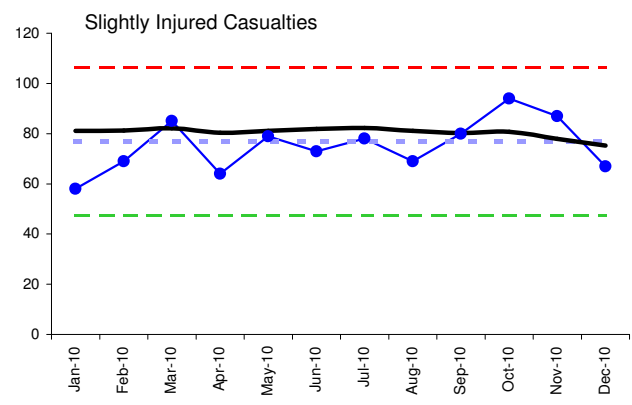
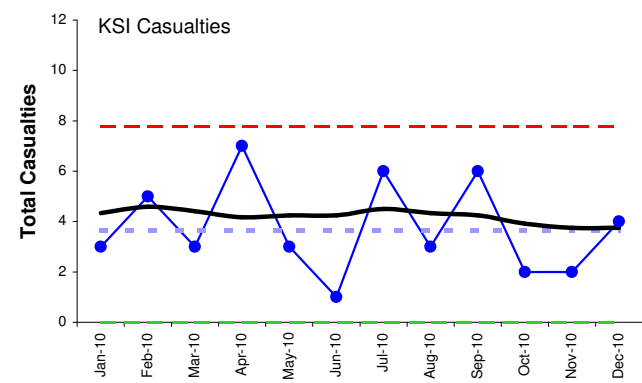
